HOW TO MAKE IT

STEP 1

Cover work area with plastic table cover and have paper towels handy to protect against any possible spills. Gather supplies.

STEP 2

For best results, prewash tablecloth to remove any finishes that may interfere with dye absorption. Leave damp.

STEP 3

Wearing rubber gloves, fill a large container or stainless steel sink with 3 gallons of very hot water. The water should ideally be 140°F. If tap water is not hot enough, heat water on the stove or kettle and add to the dyebath. Pour 1/2 bottle of well-shaken dye into dyebath.

STEP 4

To enhance the color, add one cup of salt. Add 1 teaspoon of dish detergent to help promote level dyeing. Stir well.
