



Upcycled Leather and “Turquoise” Cuff Bracelet

Make a cuff bracelet from old or discarded leather belts, and then fashion “turquoise” beads from polymer clay. Design work with additional beads and permanent markers combine to make “upcycled” adornments! cum sus, quo et rem. Est quaturestrum il is dolor rat.

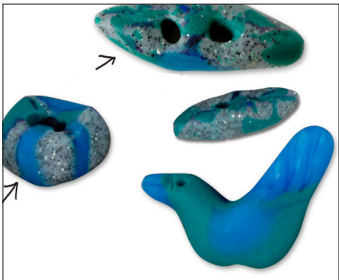
HOW TO MAKE IT



STEP 1

Cut a length of leather belt (with belt holes), approximately 2” longer than the circumference of your wrist.

If a belt with belt holes is unavailable, secure a suede lace loop to one end of the belt with glue, or punch a hole in the belt with an awl. A glued loop can then be used as a clasp. Suede



STEP 2

Create faux turquoise beads by kneading and blending three colors of Fimo Polymer Clay into interesting shapes. Punch holes in the beads and bake them in an oven following package instructions.
